Methodology

Surveys were sent through Qualtrics to a master list of 1,816 school alumni in September 2021. The alumni's year of graduation ranged from 1967-2020. Responses were sent to all 1,816 alumni via email, and over a course of one month, 277 survey responses were initiated, and 232 were completed.

The survey was designed to measure qualitative and quantitative attitudes and outcomes regarding the alumni's experience at Arizona Christian University, their continued enrollment at graduate or professional degree programs, and their employment status.
