


The Core


Freshman


Sophomore

The second year of the Core introduces you to the first two Humanities courses and linked Bible courses that enhance your understanding of the same time period.




Junior

Liberal Arts (LIA)

The first year courses ground students both in the relationships and skills they need to be successful in our Christian liberal arts university.

Bible (BIB)

A series of courses guide learners to deepen their relationship with God through His word. Everyone graduates with a Bible minor.

Humanities (HUM)

Students in these classes make powerful connections between faith, reason, and culture. We look at history, art, philosophy, theology, politics, and current events from a biblical worldview perspective.
